Arrangements for September & myth busters

- · No children are being held back a year
- Classes for September will be mixed ability and both Reception and Year 1 curriculums will be taught there is a huge overlap
- All Reception and Year 1 pupils will see each other at play time, lunch time and outdoor learning areas
- As the year progresses, children may be taught in ability groups for some subjects
- Reception children will have a Year 1 "buddy" to help them settle in
- If all Covid restrictions have been lifted, older siblings will be allowed to exit at 3pm through the same door as their younger sibling and be collected together. Children will go through their own classroom doors in the morning (Year 2 children can arrive from 8.40am to start their day with an early morning task allowing enough time for parents to walk round for Reception/Year 1 opening at 8.50am).
- With our ethos of outdoor learning and the introduction of the golden mile initiative, children will be allowed
 to wear a smart black trainer instead of a black school shoe, if they wish. The trainers must be completely
 plain with no stripes or logos. Please ensure if the child has laces that they are able to tie them
 independently.

Attendance and Family Holidays in term time

Swindon Borough Council review our attendance data very closely; overall attendance and absence levels are reviewed, with a particular focus on unauthorised absence, and specific action is taken where attendance is below 95%. Settings where there is a pattern of lower attendance are highlighted for investigation and support.

Our whole school attendance is currently 96% Cherry Tree: 94.4% Oak Tree: 96.6% Beech Tree: 97.3%

All family holidays should be taken during the school holidays; any holiday taken in term time will not be authorised and a fine may be issued, particularly if your child already has any unauthorised absence. The only time a child may be absent from school is under exceptional circumstances - cost, employment, extended family illnesses and extended family gatherings are **not** deemed as exceptional circumstances. In this case, you will need to complete an absence request form in advance .There are only 190 statutory school days in one year and 175 days (weekends and school holidays) available to use for holidays. Therefore EVERY SCHOOL DAY COUNTS!

If your child is going to be absent from school for any reason you should call the school office before 09.00am on the first day of absence. You will need to either provide a return date for your child or contact the office on each morning of your child's absence. Any unexplained absence will be registered as unauthorised. You will be asked to provide proof of appointments.
