Children will need

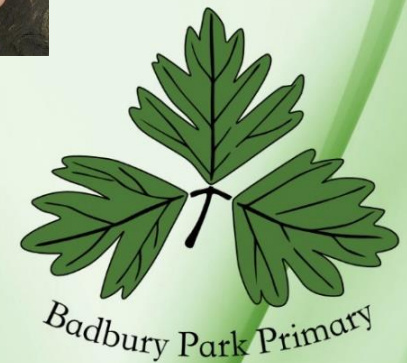
- warm and waterproof clothing

- communication skills

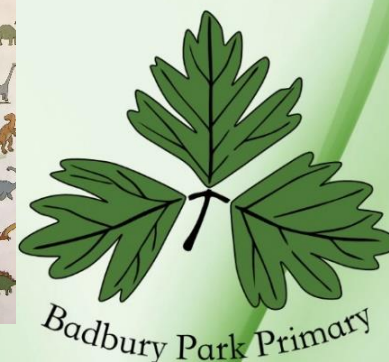
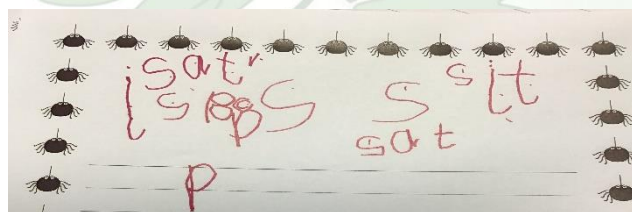
Children will build

- confidence and self esteem and a sense of awe and wonder



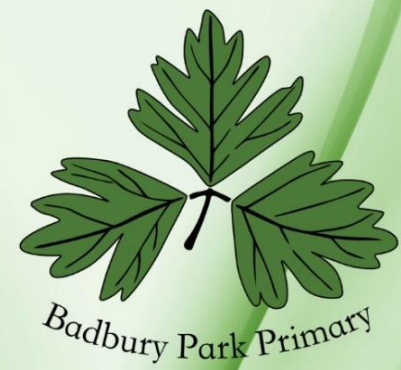


We will recap phase 1 during the first few weeks of term and assess the children's knowledge. We will then teach phase 2 and 3. Each day a new sound will be taught. It will have a 'caption action' and a 'sparkle mark'. The children will hear a story and watch a video to help them remember the sound. We will send the sound home weekly to practise at home and so the children can teach you! Very quickly the children will learn to blend sounds together to read and write words. They will also meet Tricky Troll words!



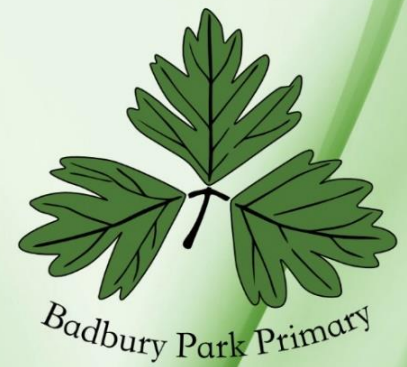
Assessments, parents' evenings and learning journeys

Induction Process

- Home visits 3rd, 4th and 7th September (via Zoom)
- Stay and Play sessions 3rd September and 4th September 9-10.30am
- Groups of ten come for a morning 8/9/10 September
- All children on 11th and 14th September for morning. 8.50-12.00
- All in half day including packed lunch till 1pm on 15/16th September
- All in full time from 17th September 8.50am-3pm



Breakfast club

- Places must be must be pre-booked and paid for in advance online



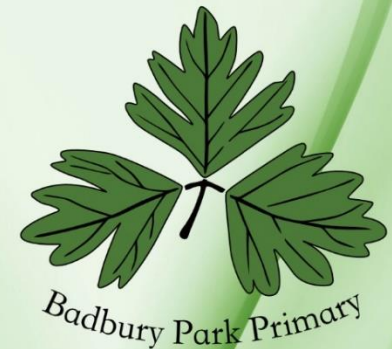
Getting Ready

What can you do?

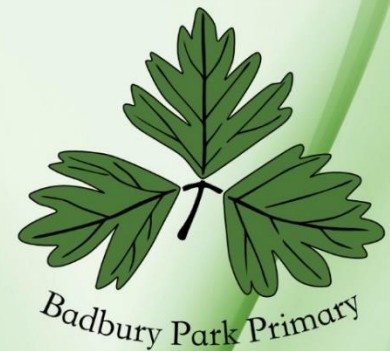
- Talk positively about school

- Cool Milk



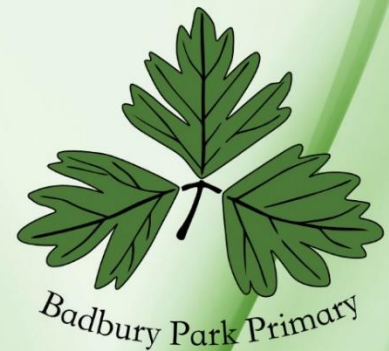

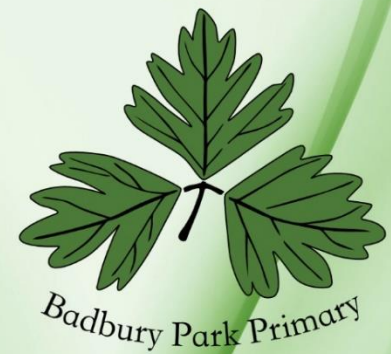
