

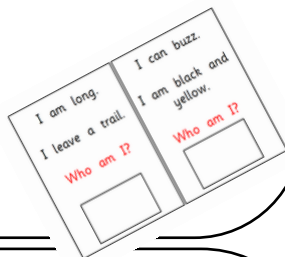
Reading and Writing

Communication and Language

'What am I?'

Write the names or draw pictures of different minibeasts on to a paper head band. Place one of the headbands onto your head- no peeking! Ask questions and try and guess which minibeast you are.

Superheroes need to use all of their senses. Take a moment to be still. Describe what you can hear, see, feel and smell. You could even play a game of guess the food- using your super tasting powers.
